**ADVERTISEMENT - UNION STANDING COMMITTEES**

Pursuant to **Article VIII of the KMPDU Constitution** and in preparation for the forthcoming Annual Delegates Conference (ADC) scheduled for **9<sup>th</sup> May 2026**, the Union hereby invites expressions of Interest from eligible members for appointment to the Union's Standing Committees.

The Union intends to constitute the following Committees to serve a term of five (5) years, in accordance with the mandates set out under **Article VIII (A), (B), (C) and (D)** of the Union Constitution:

1. Legal Affairs Committee
2. Disciplinary and Dispute Resolution Committee
3. Finance and Audit Committee
4. Communication and Public Relations Committee

1. **Eligibility and Qualifications** Candidates must be members of the Union against whose professional conduct no charge can be sustained in line with constitutional requirements for Union officers. Candidates must not have been convicted of any crime involving fraud or dishonesty.
2. **Submission Requirements** Interested and suitable candidates are required to submit the following:
  - A formal letter of intent.
  - A detailed Curriculum Vitae (CV) highlighting qualifications and relevant experience.
  - Copies of academic and professional certificates evidencing suitability for the role.
  - Proof of active Union membership.
3. **Deadline for Submission** All applications must be submitted to the Office of the Secretary General no later than **1<sup>st</sup> May 2026** at 5:00 PM. Submissions can be made via email to **nec@kmpdu.org** or delivered to the Registered Office at Blue Violets Plaza, Kindaruma Road.

Appointments to the respective Committees shall be considered and approved during the Annual Delegates Conference scheduled for **9<sup>th</sup> May 2026**.
