The independent electoral committee invites prequalification bids for the under listed services:

REQUEST FOR PREQUALIFICATION TENDER NO: IEC/PQ/1/2026: SUPPLY, DELIVERY & COMMISSIONING OF ELECTRONIC VOTING SYSTEM

1. E-Voting system Consultancy services
2. E-Voting System Requirements

The e-voting system should be a modular solution that runs the entire election process based on the following requirements:

1. The solution should clearly separate back-end vote management from front end voting process
2. Utilize block chain technology to prevent fraud, preferably an existing block chain network
3. Operate on distributed technology with servers both locally and abroad
4. Provide a user-friendly interface that is mobile friendly
5. Scale without impacting on performance
6. Should demonstrate high level of security, integrity and be cost friendly

The platform should provide the following modules:

1. Voter Registration Module	
1.1	Maintain a secure voter register
1.2	Provide for multiple voter identification methods
1.3	Allow voters to verify their details before election day
2. Voting Management Module	
2.1	Utilize One-Time-Password (OTP) to authenticate voters on the elections day
2.3	Securely authenticate and authorize each voter before voting
2.3	Allow voters to vote for different positions
2.4	Voters should only vote for positions they qualify to vote for
2.5	Restrict voter to vote only once
3. Results Management Module	
3.1	Count cast electronic votes in real time and display allowed statistics
3.2	Rank the contestants for each position and provide various statistics; number of votes received, percentage of votes received, vote difference between contestants

3.3	Provide election final results
3.4	Provide election statics; percentage voter turn-out, voter-turnout by location e.t.c
3.5	Maintain ballot secrecy during voting
4. Audit Trails and Logs	
4.1	Log every activity undertaken in the system
4.2	Ensure secure on-demand access to the logs
4.3	Allow for post-election audit of the results

In addition, all interested bidders are requested to submit their bids together with the following documents:

1. Valid KRA tax compliance certificate
2. Compliance with the Data Protection Act,2019 and the computer Misuse and Cybercrimes Act,2018
3. Valid CR12 no more than 6 months old from the date of advertisement
4. Valid Business permit
5. Certificate of incorporation
6. Company profile and past experience in electronic voter systems
7. Audited financial statements for the last 2 years
8. Detailed plan for training and knowledge transfer
9. Financial proposal
